



Special Announcement: Great News for Virginia Private Investigators and Personal Protection Specialists

Effective 12/1/2017, a Private Security Services Business licensed by DCJS can independently contract with private investigators and personal protection specialists registered with DCJS WITHOUT making them a W-2 employee.

The independent contractor is required to have minimum coverage amount of \$1 million general aggregate issued by an insurance company authorized to do business in Virginia; provide documentation verifying that they have the valid insurance to the licensed Private Security Services Business that they are contracting with, been issued a valid registration by DCJS, and entered into a contract to perform work for a licensed Private Security Services Business.
